COMMONWEALTH LITERATURE

Commonwealth literature highlights the similarities that exist among different literatures in English.

Inclusion of national literatures of those countries which do not belong to the Commonwealth.

Inclusion of national literatures of those countries which do not belong to the Commonwealth.

□ Exclusion of British literature ⇒ Reproduction of a Eurocentric view of English studies, based on the distinction between the centre and the periphery.
