COMMUNITY MOBILIZATION

Social mobilization is seen as a process for unlocking participation for collective action a course of community development. It is on going, dynamic, spiral and continuing process.

Definition:

"A process through which people are kept in action for a specific purpose by removing their visible and invisible stagnations"

The stagnant character of community is broken first with special focus on invisible stagnation that is stereotyped thinking and behavior towards life.

Community mobilization aims at making the people do what they were unwilling to do previously.

Steps of Community Mobilization:

Sensitization

Awareness

Motivation

Actionization

Sensitization:

Sensitization refers to bring realization rather actionable realization to the minds, of people and make them conscious about their needs and problems. Most of the people are unaware that they are unaware and views their problems and non-problems and issues as non-issue. However, sensitization serves pebble in the stagnant water and initiates a thinking process on community level.

(Refers to the feelings)

wareness:

Once sensitized people need to go aware about the in-depth reality of their respective commodity in terms of conditions keeping them under-developed. They are told about the extent and severity of problems.

Motivation:

Once aware people are motivated to stand up and overcome the long-standing problems and miseries. For which people are also encouraged that they themselves can do the same in a better way. Here, ideas for action are generated.

Act-ionization:

Once motivated enough people initiate collective action aiming at collective development to come out of the slight. Here all stagnations are broken and removed and insiders become active participant of development course.
