The Last Sermon (Khutbah) of Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him)

Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) delivered his last sermon (Khutbah) on the ninth of Dhul Hijjah at the Valley of mount Arafat. His words were quite clear and concise and were directed to the entire humanity.

After praising, and thanking Allah he said:

Learn that every Muslim is a brother to every Muslim and that the Muslims constitute one brotherhood.
