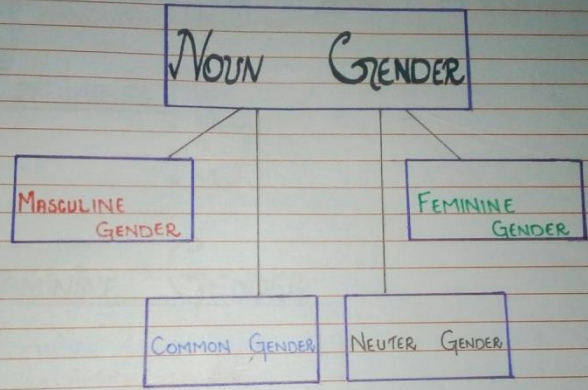

## MASCULINE GENDER

A noun that refers a male is said to be of masculine gender.

### EXAMPLES

- King
- Boy
- Man

## FAMININE GENDER

A noun that refers a female is said to be of feminine gender.

### EXAMPLES

- Queen
- Girl
- Woman

## COMMON GENDER

A noun that refers to either male or female is said to be of common gender.

### EXAMPLES

- Student
- Friend
- Child

## NEUTER GENDER

A noun that refers to a non living thing is called neuter gender.

### EXAMPLES

- Table
- Chair
- Box

# PRONOUN

A pronoun is a word used instead of noun.

## EXAMPLES

- I am a good girl.
- He is very intelligent.

## SUBJECT PRONOUNS

Pronouns can take the place of nouns as the subject of a sentence. Subject pronouns include he, she, we, they and it.

### EXAMPLES

- He and she joined us at the theater.
- He poured cereal into his bowl.

## OBJECT PRONOUN

An object pronoun is used as the direct indirect object or the object of a preposition.

### EXAMPLES

- The teacher gave her a reprimand.
- I will tell you a story.

## POSSESSIVE PRONOUN

A possessive pronoun is a pronoun that is used to indicate possession or ownership.

### EXAMPLES

- We shall finally have what is rightfully ours.
- Their mother gets along well with yours.
