Rules of Writing:

- Mass/ Non- count nouns are always used singular.
- Articles are not used with them.
- Some nouns are always plural. For example:

Instruments having two parts.

Dresses in pair.

Certain collective nouns.

- Some nouns have same singular and plural form.
- Nouns with Numbers are singular.

• Each of, either of, One of: plural nouns are used after them. For example:

- 1. One of my **friends** is an engineer.
- Some nouns look plural but are used with singular verbs.

For example:

News, Subjects, Common Diseases, some games.

Mass noun that are non-count are used as singular:

1. Advice, bread, knowledge etc.
