• Types of Nouns:

4. Abstract nouns:

They refer to the ideas, qualities and conditions. The things which cannot be seen or touched and the things which have no physical reality.

e.g. truth, happiness, time, humor, friendship

5. Collective nouns:

It refers to the group of people or things

e.g. family, team, faculty, cattle, band

6. Countable nouns:

those which can be counted have both singular and plural forms woman / women

e.g. bunch of bananas

7. Uncountable / mass nouns:

nouns that cannot be counted. They have no plural form

e.g. rice, sugar, rain, flour, wine, hair
