## Verb

A verb is a word that describes an action being done by someone or something.

# For example The Horse is Running.




## KINDS OF VERB

- Transitive Verb
- Intransitive verb

### Transitive Verb

> Transitive verbs are action verbs that have an object to receive that action.

For Example:-



## Intransitive Verb

Intransitive verbs are action verbs but unlike transitive verbs, they do not have an object receiving the action.

#### For Example:-

Verbs

- He Laughed
- He Jumped

### **Further Types**

There are 3 further types of verbs:

- Action Verb
- Helping Verb
- Linking Verb

#### Action Verb

This tells what the subject is doing

- Ran
- Walk
- Swim
- Tell
- Hide

#### Helping Verb

Also called an auxiliary verb, which combines with a main verb to help it express the tense, mood, and voice.

They are added before the verb.

Common helping verbs

Be do have can may

will shall are is

#### Linking Verb

Connects or links a subject to a noun or an adjective in a predicate

For example:-

Subject Noun

Messi is a football player.

Verbs such as smell, look, taste, feel, remain, turn, appear, become, sound, seem, grow, stay can also be linking verbs.
