

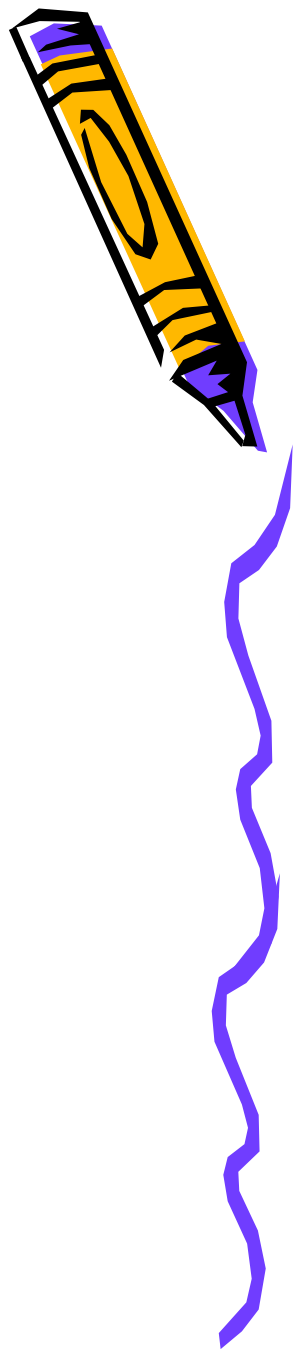

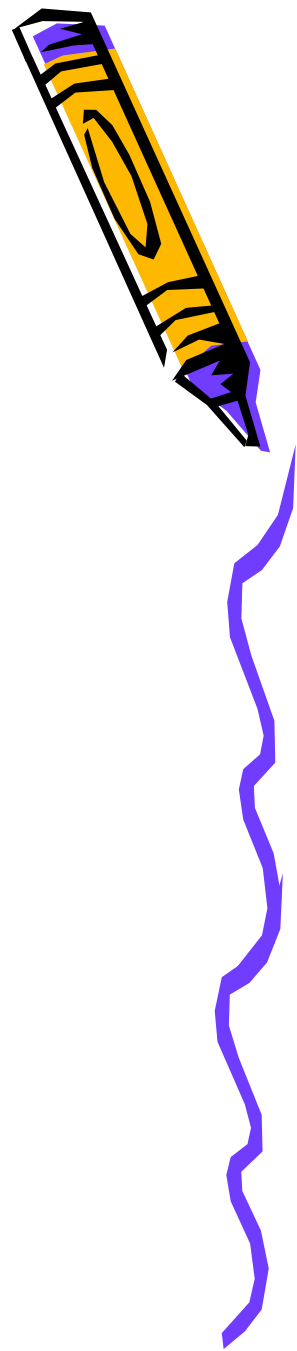


Meaning of Preposition



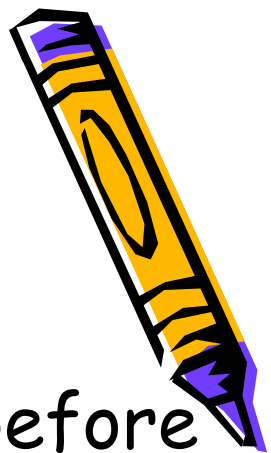
PREPOSITION

- PREPOSITION TELLS US THE POSITION OF SOMETHING IN RELATION TO ANOTHER.



Definition

A preposition is a word which is placed before a noun or a pronoun to show its relation with something else in the sentence



Based on their use in a sentence



The prepositions are divided
into categories of:

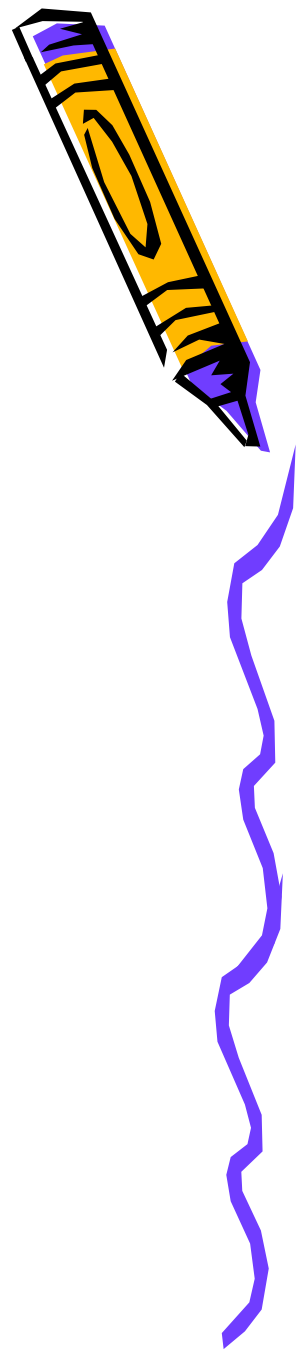
- Preposition of place
- Preposition of time
- Preposition of movement



Examples for preposition of place:



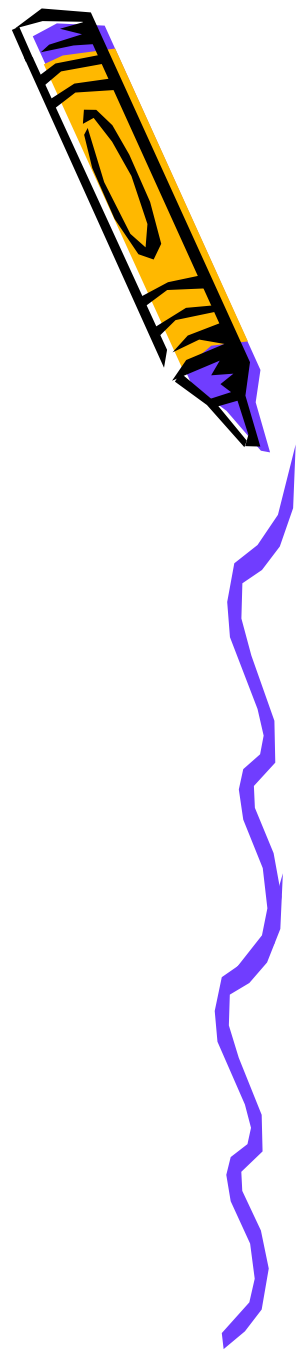
- The airplane is flying above the clouds.





- 2. The book is kept under the table





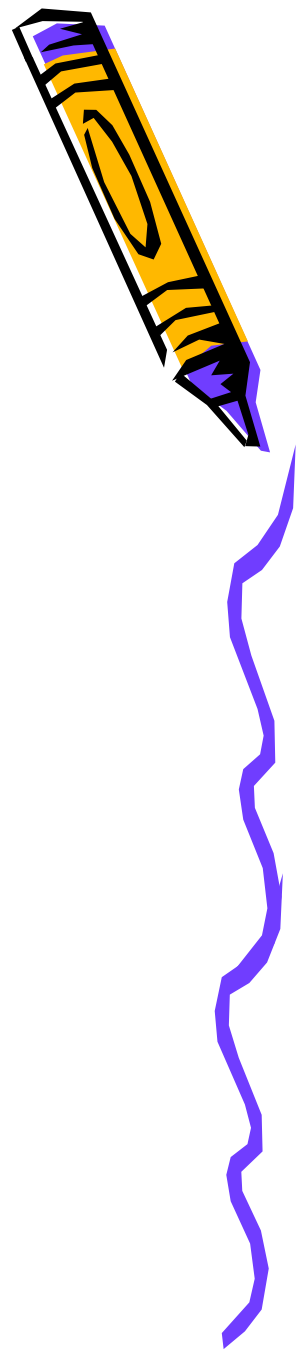
Preposition of Place:

- *It refer to those preposition which can be used to show where something is located*

- Above, up, after, on, before,
against, by, behind, below,
along, near, down, in, at,
across, inside, between, over



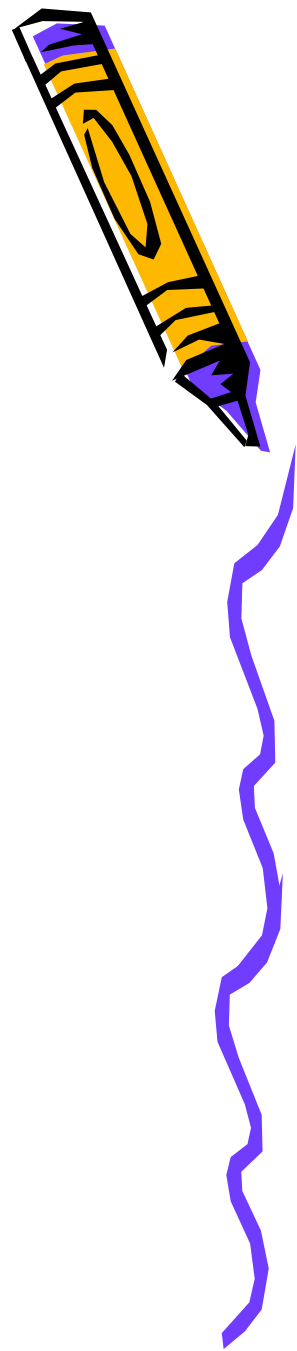
Examples for preposition of time:



1. We went to eat ice - cream at night

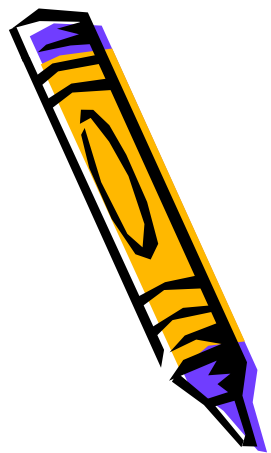


2. I go for a walk in the morning.



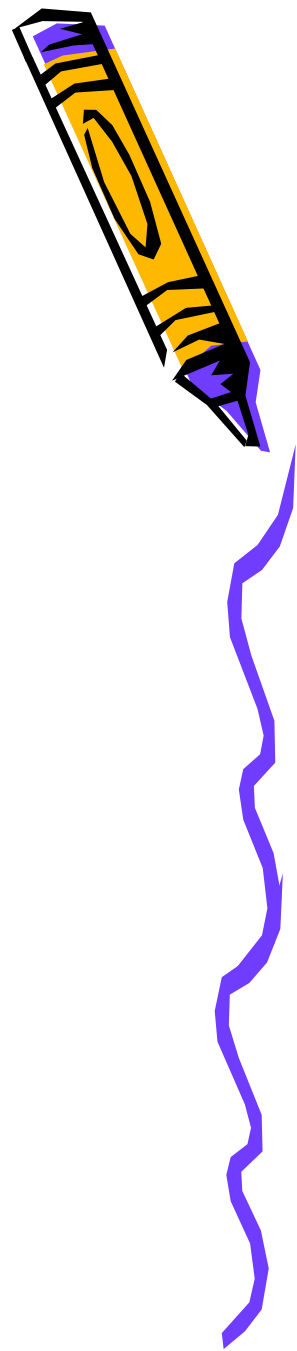
Preposition of Time :

- It helps to link the noun or pronoun with a time value. It functions as an indicator as to what point of time did an event occur.

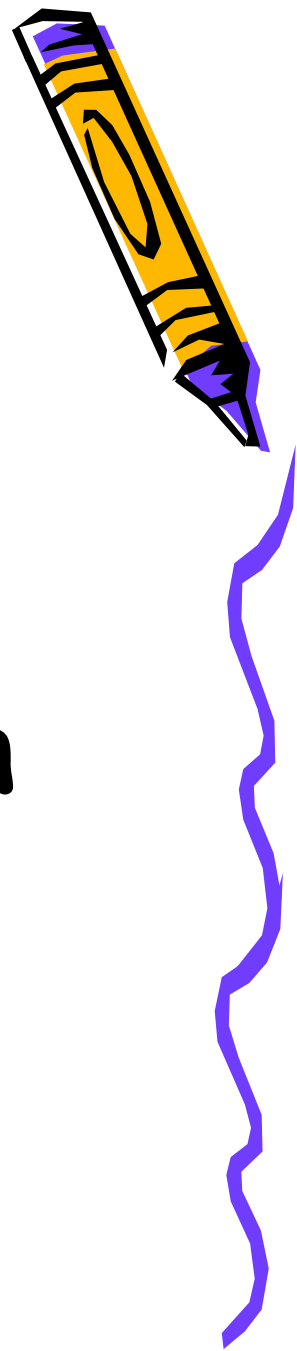


Here are some examples for preposition of time:

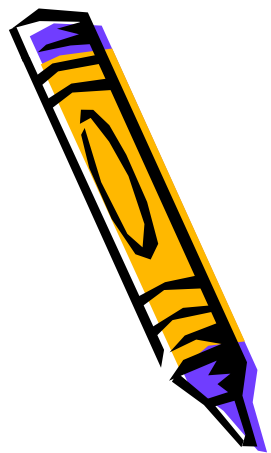

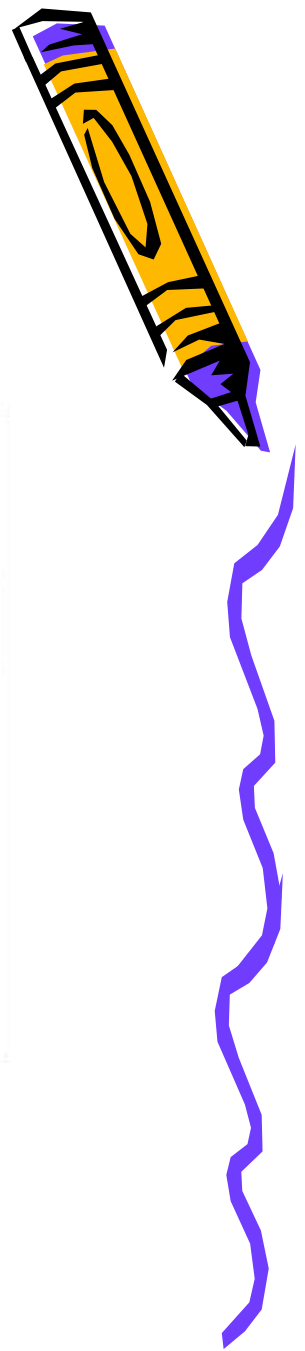
Preposition of place :

- This shop is open _____ Monday to Sunday

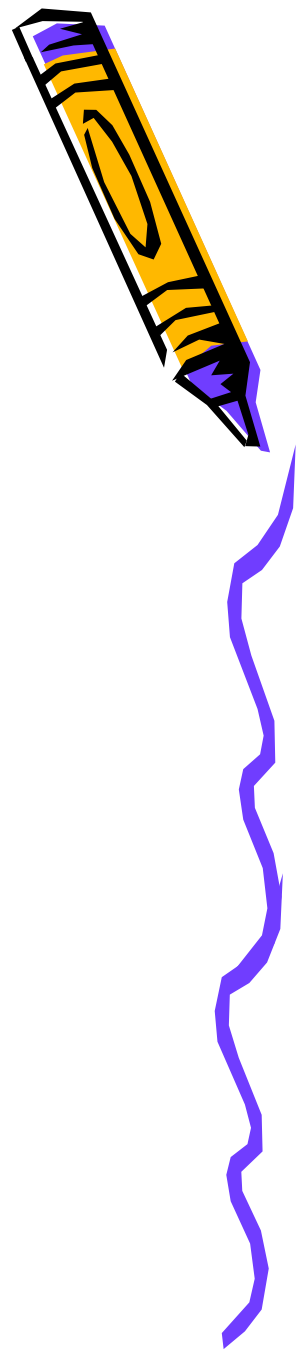


Preposition of time

This shop is open from Monday to Sunday.



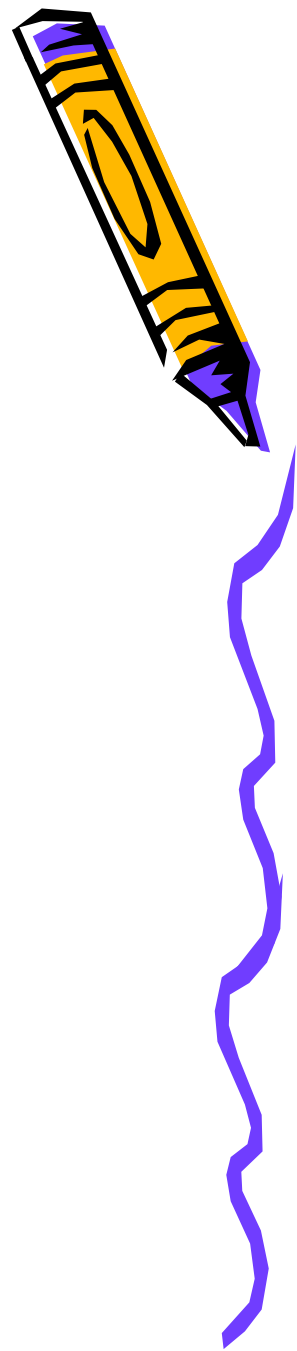
Examples for preposition of movement

2. He jumped into the river.



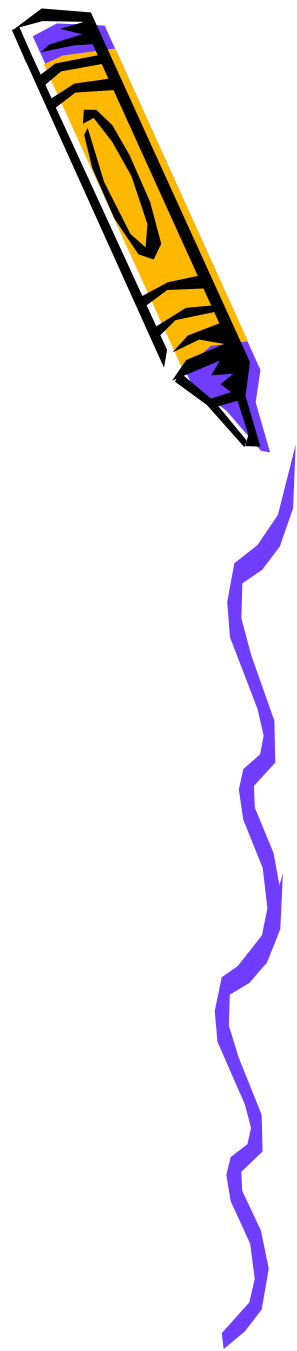
Preposition of Movement

- A preposition of movement is used to show movement to or from a place

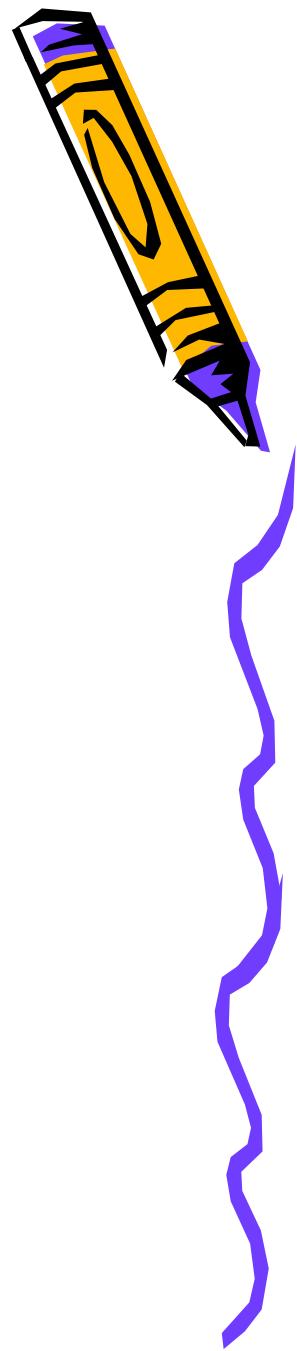


Here are some examples for preposition of movement:

Based on their use in a sentence



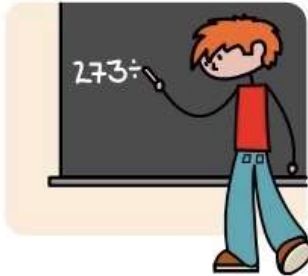
The prepositions are divided

- Preposition of movement



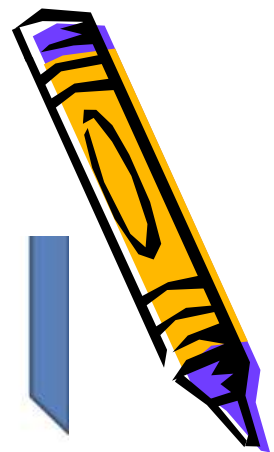

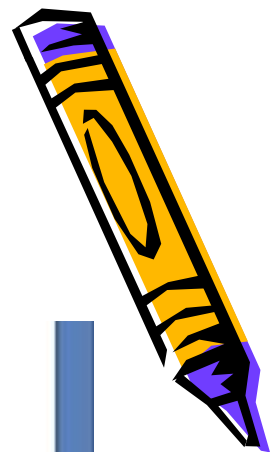

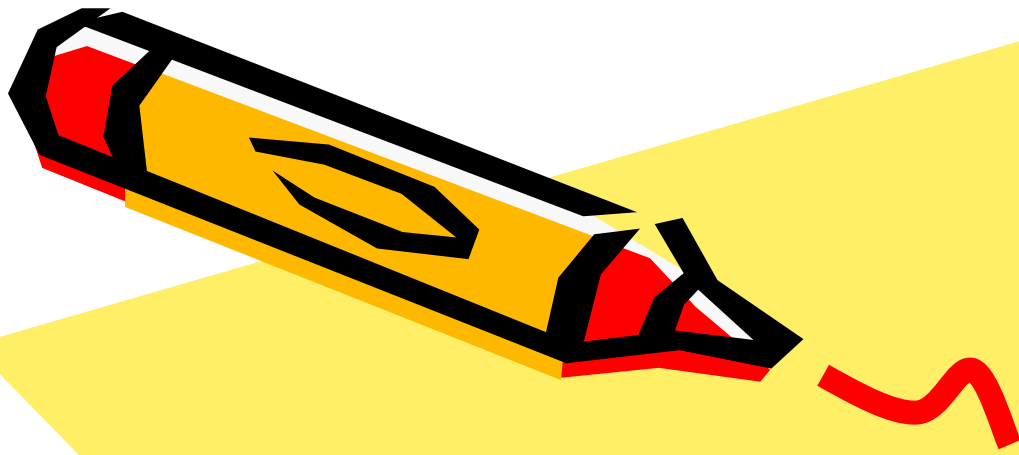
