PREPOSITION

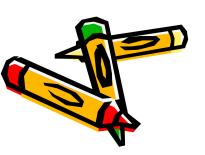
 PREPOSITION TELLS US THE POSITION OF SOMETHING IN RELATION TO ANOTHER.





Definition

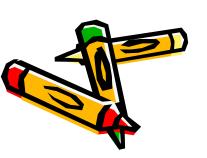
A preposition is a word which is placed before a noun or a pronoun to show its relation with something else in the sentence

The airplane is flying <u>above</u> the clouds.





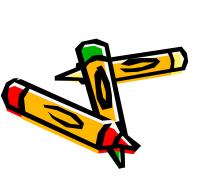
· 2. The book is kept under the table

Here are some examples for preposition of place:


 Above, up, after, on, before, against, by, behind, below, along, near, down, in, at, across, inside, between, over



Examples for preposition of time:


1. We went to eat ice - cream <u>at night</u>





2.I go for a walk in the morning.








Preposition of Time:




 It helps to link the noun or pronoun with a time value. It functions as an indicator as to what point of time did an event occur.



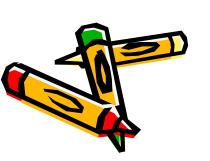
Here are some examples for preposition of time:

 About, before, for, by, around, in, ago, at, past, since, to, on, after, until, between, during









The cat is sitting on the bench

This shop is open <u>from</u> Monday to Sunday.









Examples for preposition of movement

1. Children are going to school








2. He jumped into the river.










Preposition of Movement

 Down, past, into, behind, up, onto, through, off, over, on, across, at, by, for, after, towards

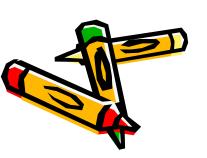
