
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Introduction to Sociology






- Study of development, structure and functioning of human society

- It helps a lot in decision making and gains a better understanding that shapes your life.





Basically, science of sociology was established in 19th century


Social sciences deals with man and his activities in society



Relationship between Sociology and Political Science

Sociology and political science are so closely and deeply related to each other that one become meaningless without the other.

According to Morris Ginsberg "Historically Sociology has its roots in politics and philosophy in history"

Sociology is the fundamental social science, which studies man's social life as a whole and attempt to discover the facts and laws of life as a whole.

Political science on the other hand, is concerned with the political life of a man, which is one part of his total life

Sociology depends very much on political science in every aspect. The state and the government makes laws for the welfare of the society: the government removes the social evils such as poverty, unemployment, dowry and so on from the society. The undesirable coustoms are uprooted from the society by the government.

Social institutions and social organizations are regulated by the state and the government. Sociology studies various aspects of political activities through the help of political science. The government can bring about changes in the society with the help



In the same way, political science depends upon sociology and sociology provides material to political science that is the political life of the people. Therefore, some sociologist regard political science as a special branch of sociology, it can be said that without sociological background the study of political science is quite impossible. The forms of government, the nature of governmental organs the law and the sphere of the state activity are chiefly determined by the social process.

The laws which are formed by the government are based on the social customs and traditions of the society.

Most of the changes which have been taken place in the political theory, during the past times have been possible due to sociology. For understanding of political problems, some knowledge about sociology is very essential because all political problems are mainly corrected with a social aspects.



In this connection F.H Gidding says "To teach the theory of state to men who have not learn the first principle of sociology is like teaching astronomy or thermodynamics to men who have not learnt Newton's law of Motion."

Thus, sociology and political science depend upon each other. Both are inter-related and inter-dependend. Truly it can be said that society is the mirror of politics of country. According to G.E.G Callin,

"Sociology and political science are the two faces of the same figure"

In the opinion of E.G Wilson "It must be admittes of course, that it is often difficult to determine, whether a particular writer should be considered as a sociologist or political theorist or philosopher".

Sociology and Economics

- Economics deals with the economics activities of man.
- It also be understood as the science of wealth in its three stages namely: production, distribution and consumption.
- It studies man as a wealth-getter and wealth disposer.
- It studies the interrelations of <u>purely economic factors and forces</u>: the relations of price and supply, money flows, input-output ratios and like.



 Knowledge of property, division of labor, occupations, industrial organization, etc., is provided by a sociologists to an economist.

 Labor relations, standard of living, employer-employee relations, social classes, socio-economic planning, socioeconomic reforms, etc., are common to both economists





SOCIOLOGY OF NURSING

- Industrial development (industrialization) affect the condition of sociological community, and sociological conditions affect the development of industrial society.


- It deals with study of interaction of human in technological change, globalization, labor markets, work organization, and managerial practices.

SOCIOLOGY OF AGEING
