## What is plant resistance?

- When (heritable) plant qualities results in a relatively less plant damage by insects as compare to plant without these qualities
- e.g., ??
- Hairiness of cotton for sucking pests
- Bt cotton for lepidopterous, such as Heliothes spp, Spodoptera spp, Mythimna spp
- Pectinophora gossypiella (PBW)??????

- Gossypol glands
